Our Programs

Royal Family Kids' Camp (RFKC)

RFKC is a unique summer camp that is specially designed for children in foster care who are 7 to 11 years old.

Teen Reach Adventure Camp (TRAC)

TRAC is a unique summer camp that is specially designed for children in foster care who are 12 to 15 years old.

Arizona Princess Program

The Arizona Princess Program is a formal dinner party for teenage girls in foster care. The evening includes dresses, shoes, jewelry, professional hair dressers and make-up artists and ballroom dancing.

Arizona All-Star Program

The Arizona All-Star Program is an opportunity for teenage boys in foster care to be treated like All-Stars and meet local sport celebrities.

Annual Christmas Party

We host an annual Christmas party for the foster families and their foster children who attended TRAC or RFKC.

John S. Brewer Memorial Scholarship Fund

The John S. Brewer Memorial Scholarship Fund was created to help any child who has attended TRAC or RFKC. Only 1% of former foster children ever graduate from college. Through the fund, we provide educational assistance and college scholarships to foster children.

Children in foster care need compassion for their circumstances that is actively demonstrated through love and encouragement. We provide acceptance to the abandoned and neglected children who have been rejected and offer reliable programs to meet their needs. Through summer camps, an annual Christmas party and educational support we serve the children in foster care and provide hope and a future to them.

Did You Know?

- ▶ 35,000 reports of child abuse or neglect were made in Arizona last year
- ▶ A teenage foster child has less than a 10% chance of ever being adopted
- ▶ A thirteen-year-old foster child has a 50% chance of being incarcerated for an offense before turning 18
- ▶ Only 1% of former foster children ever graduate from college

Because of statistics like this, Hope & A Future was formed to bring hope and a future to Arizona foster children.
